### Welcome to Walsall's SEND Local Offer

As part of Walsall Council's SEND Local offer, they have a wide range of information and resources available available for you to access on their website. The website gives children and young people with SEND, and their families, information about what support services the local authority has available in the local area. They also have a video that explains all that is involved in the local offer for Walsall and this can be found at the bottom of the home page.



### A Spotlight on...





Rocket Phonics is a DfE Certified phonics programme. Here at St Giles, children primarily learn the sounds of the alphabet and to read words through the RWI Programme. However, Rocket Phonics correlates very closely with RWI and can offer an alternative way for children to learn sounds, if they have not retained taught sounds from Year 1 onwards. A number of children in Year 2 currently have access to bespoke Rocket Phonics sessions each week. The programme allows children to learn and retain taught sounds with a focus upon comprehension. During the session, pupils have access to a multi-sensory learning environment through the use of LED boards for letter formation and interactive books that correlate with the sound focus for that day!

In addition, pupils also have the opportunity to access a peer to peer reading club, using Rocket Phonics texts as a basis, where

older pupils read on a 1-1 basis with younger pupils to develop their confidence, academic resilience and reading fluency!



### of SEND Terms:

#### **Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP)**

An Education, Health and Care plan (EHC plan) is a legal document which describes a child or young person's aged up to 25 special educational needs, the support they need, and the outcomes they would like to achieve.

The special educational provision described in an EHC plan must be provided by the child or young person's local authority. This means an EHC plan can give a child or young person extra educational support. It can also give parents and young people more choice about which school or other setting the child or young person can attend.

An EHC plan can only be issued after a child or young person has gone through the process of an Education, Health

and Care needs assessment.
