### Curriculum

The children will be diving into some exciting topics this term, such as 'Me and My Community'—where the children will learn all about themselves, their families and friends and people who help us such as police officers and nurses. We will also be exploring the season of Autumn and finding out why leaves turn orange and why squirrels hide their nuts! In the second half of Autumn term we will learn about Superheroes and discover lots of traditional tales in our topic 'Once Upon a Time', we will identify and learn about the characters and will use our creativity to role play and retell these tales.
