









Question: Are you aware of the DFE's Remote Learning Expectations.







Question : Is the school meeting the DFE expectations?







Question: Are you aware of your child's current targets?







Question: Has your child continued to make progress and learn during current closure?







Question: Do you think our Remote Learning is of high quality?







Question: Has your child had access to daily live teaching/contact from their teacher?







Question: Does the Remote Learning curriculum cover areas of the curriculum beyond Maths and English?







Question: Does the school provide quality feedback for your child to maintain learning? Inc Chat/Live
